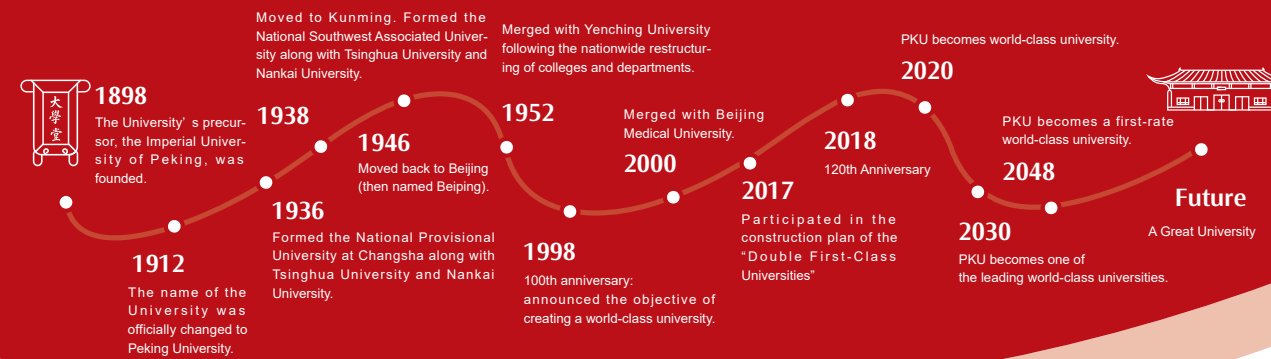
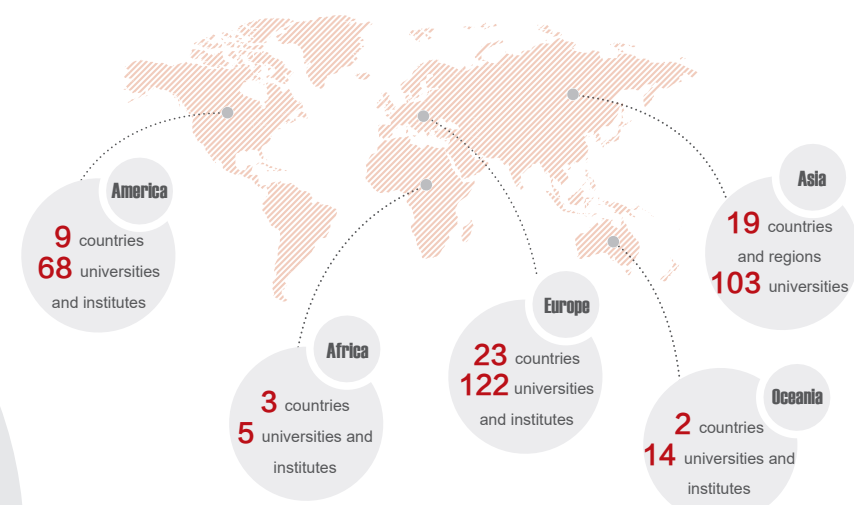

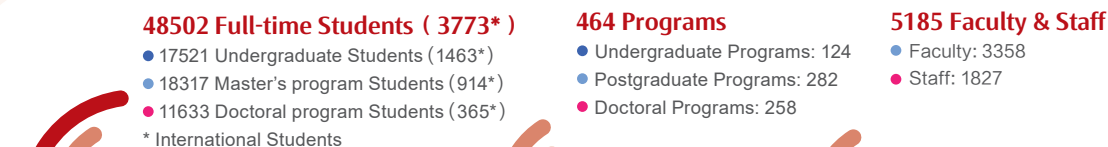

About PKU's Short-term Programs

Peking University actively promotes international communication and cooperation by organizing short-term study programs in China, both independently and in cooperation with world-renowned overseas universities. It welcomes a large number of outstanding students from all over the world to study at the university and is committed to cultivating leading talents through PKU's heritage, Chinese sentiments, and international innovation. In terms of time, short-term programs usually last fewer than 6 months and are concentrated in three periods: spring semester, summer vacation, and fall semester. In terms of program nature, we offer: Chinese language training; the "On the Road to China" program, which focuses on China studies; and the "Succeeding in China" program, which integrates innovation/entrepreneurship courses and internship. As for student recruitment platforms, our open platform programs welcome applications from all over the world while our tailored group programs are open to particular partner universities/institutes. At present, our open platform programs include the Chinese Language Program in the spring; the PKU Summer School International; the Chinese Language Summer School; the LSE-PKU Summer School; and the Globex Summer Program. At the same time, we also have a number of cooperative programs with overseas universities, such as the University of Oxford, Cambridge University, the University of Sydney, Nanyang Technological University, and Waseda University.

Short-term study abroad programs in China recruit Sinophile international students who are of good character; healthy; and have no criminal record in China. The programs offer a variety of Chinese and English courses covering many themes. Application can be made via our convenient and quick online application system. On-campus (or nearby) accommodation can also be arranged in some cases. A range of teaching and learning methods as well as cultural exchange activities are offered.

Peking University also has a broad range of degree courses and long-term programs.

Open Platform Programs

After the establishment of New China, Peking University's teaching of Chinese as a foreign language can be traced back to its "Chinese Language Program for Foreign Students" program, in 1952. In the sixty years since, Peking University has produced a number of "firsts" in the field of teaching Chinese as a foreign language, and has trained thousands of outstanding students with knowledge of the Chinese language, ancient culture and history, allowing them to make a contribution to a community of shared future for mankind.

★ Four-week Chinese Language Program in Spring

This program was established in 1982, and, since then, around one hundred students have participated every year. Traditionally, this program attracted mostly Japanese students, but, in recent years, the cohort has become more and more diverse. Increasing numbers of students from Europe, the USA, and countries along the "Belt and Road" have participated. The program offers different levels of Chinese language classes and lectures on Chinese culture taught in English or Japanese. It also features a range of cultural activities and field trips.

★ Chinese Language Summer School

This program was established in 1980. Each year, over 300 students from over twenty countries take part. This program has three durations to choose from: four weeks; six weeks; or eight weeks. The classes are divided into beginner, intermediate, and advanced levels, and the program also features a lecture series on "China's national situation and culture," as well as exchanges between Chinese and foreign students and field trips in and around Beijing.

★ PKU Summer School International

This program was established in 2009. In recent years, over 400 students from over twenty countries have taken part each year. This program offers a variety of courses at different levels, taught in English. It also involves student exchanges and excursions. Students who participate and successfully complete their studies can earn credits from PKU.

Program Duration: July 1, 2019 to July 26, 2019
Application Period: January 1, 2019 to May 31, 2019
Application fee: RMB 400 yuan
Tuition fee: RMB 9000-16000 yuan (depends on how many credits), those who apply before March 31, 2019, are entitled to an early-bird tuition fee discount.

★ LSE-PKU Summer School

This program was established in 2004 and is well known in the Asia-Pacific region. In recent years, over 400 students from more than forty countries have participated each year. This program is taught in English by academics from both universities. It focuses on major current issues in the Asia-Pacific region, with students from diverse backgrounds drawing on approaches from both the humanities and the social sciences.

Program Duration: August 5, 2019 to August 16, 2019
Application Period: January 1, 2019 to June 15, 2019

★ Globex Summer School

This program was established in 2012. In recent years, more than 300 students have participated each year. The program is organized by Peking University's School of Engineering as a multi-disciplinary course centered on engineering and taught by internationally renowned professors. Students who participate in the program and successfully complete their studies can earn credits from PKU.

Application Period: February 1, 2019 to May 31, 2019

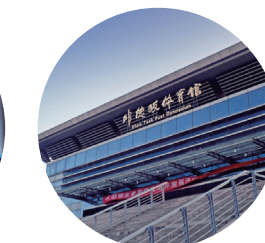
